uCan is a free software application that enables you to capture screenshots of your Windows desktop and share them with others via email, Twitter or social media websites. Installation: After downloading and unzipping the package, it needs to be installed via the tool's context menu, from an extracted.zip archive. The application can be run from any folder. Accessibility via the system tray At startup, uCan creates an icon in the system tray area, which may be brought to the desktop by right-clicking it. As it is not always necessary to upload screenshots directly to social media websites, the tool has an option to send them to a separate folder instead. Easily configure settings uCan offers you a wide range of options, which can be changed via the tray icon's right-click menu. The Hotkey field allows you to configure the default Windows hotkey for capturing the screen. You can also enter the necessary username and password for Dropbox. There are two ways of sharing the screenshots: via the clipboard or the default Windows default image viewer. Use the search engine to locate links to pre-written scripts, which you may use to capture the screen and to take a picture of the window or any region of it. Users can also control the settings, such as the timer of up to 60 seconds, size of screenshots, quality and file format of images. Evaluation and conclusion uCan is a powerful tool that enables users to capture the screen, convert them into multiple formats, as well as to save them to the default local directory or an FTP server. It works fine and quickly, and provides a good range of options. Description: Just a Game is a free software tool that enables you to capture screenshots of your Windows desktop and upload them to a FTP server. Installation: After downloading and unzipping the package, you can run the executable file directly from the archive. Accessibility via the system tray At startup, Just a Game creates a tray icon, which may be brought to the desktop by right-clicking it. CameraMax is a free photo editor and a screen capture utility that enables you to take screenshots and edit them at the same time. It can capture the entire screen or a selected window and save the images to a local directory, a Flickr account or upload them to a Facebook account. Interface At launch, CameraMax creates an icon in the system tray area. You can use the tool without the interface, but you'll have to manually select the screen or window that you want to capture. Clicking on the tray icon opens the interface, which displays the current file name, local directory, image type and resolution. It also gives you the option to choose the image format (PNG, JPG, GIF), the preview and direct URL. It also has a tool bar with buttons to rotate, move and resize the captured image. Although the interface is intuitive, there are some things that we would like to point out: The "Preview" button should be named "Preview" instead of "Edit". It enables you to edit the current image with the image editor. This leads to a clash of buttons that looks very messy. Another thing is that the orientation of the images is not altered when saving them, which may lead to people mixing their screens/pictures. All in all, you can capture the screen or a window and save the images to a local directory, Flickr or Facebook. You can configure settings such as the file name, hotkey for capturing the screen and including the mouse cursor. Functionality The program runs on low CPU and RAM. It doesn't crash, and it didn't hang on us during our evaluation. The possibility to define an application hotkey to capture the screen should be available to everyone. You can also disable the automatic recording of video, and you may also exclude the mouse cursor. We have not encountered any issues with our evaluation, but we do suggest you keep your feedback to a minimum, as there are bugs that may arise if you use the software for a while. BrowseRatio is a simple yet powerful screen recorder designed to capture the screen and export them in a variety of ways. It allows you to capture the entire screen, a specific window, or a region by drawing a rectangle. The tool supports both local and online image backups, and it has many customization options for almost every feature. Accessibility BrowseRatio creates an icon in the system tray area, and it can be configured to display a notification when the user

To remove them, run: Code: dpkg --purge [package name] To remove them all, run: Code: dpkg --purge [package name] | grep -i [package name] This will show you all packages that were installed at some point
